GENERAL INFORMATION

Title: Make Youth Active Citizens of Tomorrow

Place: Campina, Romania

Date: **22.04 – 30.04.2022**

• **22.04.2022 is arrival day**

• **30.04.2022 is departure day**

Participants: 30 young people, 16-25 years old and 5 leaders (no age limit for a leader), so in total 35 persons.

Partners: Bulgaria, Italy, Slovakia, Poland and Romania.

Dear partners, please select one leader and 6 participants for this project (7 persons in total), gender balance is recommending but not obligatory. We kindly ask each partner to send the list of participants not later than 4th of April 2022.

Participants and leaders will need a valid EU Digital COVID Certificate that proof that a person has either been vaccinated against COVID-19 or recovered from COVID-19. We will update you with Romanian regulations before the project start.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Together with our partners, we propose that this project create a general framework, which should become a starting point for creating a local development strategy for young people, thus promoting the development of programs and projects for greater participation of young people in decision-making and supporting partnerships between/for youth structures and local administration. This project consists of a youth mobility, a youth exchange that will involve 30 young people from Italy, Poland, Bulgaria, Slovakia and Romania, for 7 days, in a challenge to better understand the importance of involving young people in life community, in decision-making processes and in dedicated activities. The methodology to be used will include methods based on communication (interaction, dialogue, open discussions), methods based on activities (exchange of experience, practice and experimentation), methods focused on the social side (partnerships, teamwork, group activity) and methods of self-knowledge (creativity, discovery, responsibility, action).

Each participant will receive at the end of the project the **Youthpass Certificate**.

PLACE

Campina is a city in Prahova County, Romania, located on the main route between Wallachia and Transylvania. Campina is the town where are the most sunny days in Romania and is located near to the Carpathians Mountains. From Bucharest to Campina is about 1 h travel by train. Its existence is first attested in a document of 1503. It is situated in the historical region of Muntenia.



ACCOMODATION

We will be accommodated in the comfortable Montana Hotel. Be prepared to be accommodated 2, 3 or 4 persons in one room. Each room has private toilet and shower. There is Free-Wi-Fi in the entire building. No need to bring towels or sleeping bags.

HOW TO REACH CAMPINA

If you come by plane, there is only one nearest airport – Otopeni (Bucharest). This airport is very well connected with Campina thanks to trains, which run from the early morning to the late evening. The cost of the train from airport to Bucharest (Gara de Nord) is about €1 and from Bucharest (same station Gara de Nord) to Campina is about €6.

If you travel by any other means (train, bus, van), please ask us for the best advices.

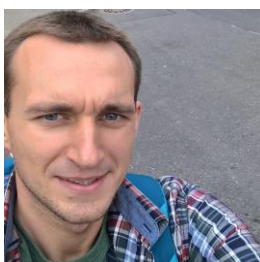


PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

CURRENCY IN ROMANIA

The Romanian currency is Leu (RON), 1 EURO is about 4.9 RON.

INSURANCE

The participants are required by Erasmus+ Programme to have valid travel insurance for the whole period of the project including the travel days or the European health insurance card.

LANGUAGE

The official language of the project will be English. All the workshops and sessions will be implemented in English.

FOOD REQUIREMENTS

Apart of standard nutrition based on regional cuisine we are able to provide vegetarian, vegan food or special nutrition but you must consult with us before your arrival to the project if we are able to fill your needs.

COSTS AND TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT

Food, accommodation and materials during the youth exchange are fully provided. The travel costs will be reimbursed as soon as you send us all necessary documents such as tickets and boarding cards. Travelling by taxi or first class tickets is ineligible and the costs will not be reimbursed.

For the travel reimbursement purpose participants must provide to the group leader their tickets, bills and boarding cards in electronic or physical form that includes price, connection description and name of participant (in case of flight tickets). For your plane ticket we will need also your boarding card for each single connection. All the documents need to be delivered in electronic version (PDF) or physical form. Even though you use the mobile app on your phone, download the PDF and send it to us. Because of accounting rules, we can NOT accept print screens from your phone.

The E+ Programme and Romanian National Agency require from participants to use the time and cost efficient way of transportation. To ensure that obligation we require from participants, before purchasing any plane ticket consult it with us. We expect to be informed about the chosen connection including time, date and price of your flight. The following information should be

delivered to us (iorga_alexandru@yahoo.com) before you purchase your tickets. Before purchasing flight tickets, you have to receive our written confirmation. Otherwise you risk your ticket will not be reimbursing.

In case participants want to come earlier or depart later from a project venue, they can only arrive 2 days before the youth exchange starting date and depart 2 days after the youth exchange end date, in order to still be eligible for travel cost reimbursement. In that case participants must cover their own expenses in that additional days (accommodation, food etc.) and consult this with the coordinator.

Travel reimbursement can be fully removed to the people who:

- do not take part in the whole length of the youth exchange;
- skip the workshops;
- repeatedly break the basic rules and not react to warnings or commit serious misbehaviour;
- do not contribute to the dissemination phase of the project.

The reimbursement will be done ONLY by bank transfer to your sending organization or group leader for entire group in one payment. After we made the bank transfer, each sending organization or group leader will give you the money related to your personal costs but not more than the limits mentioned above.
