
The hosting organization will provide the participants with food (3 meals per day). Please inform us in advance if you have any dietary requirements!

Currency

The currency in Bulgaria is lev (BGN). Its rate to Euro is fixed (it cannot change), 1 Euro = 1.955 BGN.



Transport costs

Participants in training for youth workers can have their travel expenses reimbursed according to Erasmus + travel calculator: https://erasmusplus.ec.europa.eu/resources-andtools/distance-calculator

The reimbursement covers only travelling by plane, train and bus metro... The money paid for a taxi cannot be reimbursed! Please keep all receipts and invoices with you. Print all your tickets and invoices if the tickets are bought online.

IMPORTANT: You will get your reimbursement after WE HAVE RECEIVED all your travel documents. You will receive your reimbursement money through your sending organization, so you need to inform them about the details of your bank account. We are forced to do this because in the past a lot of participants had delay in sending their boarding passes to us and we were not able to submit our final report on time. If you travel only by bus, we just need your tickets.



What to prepare for the activities:

-Energizers (each day a different national team will perform them)
-Souvenirs, food and drinks typical of your country (for the intercultural coffee breaks)
The details of your personal bank account in your country of residence as well as the details of the bank account of your sending organization (you can ask them for this).

THE PARTICIPANT IN THE PROJECT CONFIRMS THAT SHE/HE:

1. Is informed that the

training IS NOT AN ACADEMIC PROJECT. The activities will not be of academic nature, i.e. there will not be any lectures neither academic type of discussions. The proposed activities will be only introduction into the topic. The trainers and the experts present during the project are not university lecturers.

2. Is informed that the

methods used during the activities are methods of INFORMAL and NON-FORMAL EDUCATION. That means, the participant will be actively involved in the activities. This includes also being on time for all the activities.

3. Agrees with the financial

conditions of the reimbursement, more precisely: (1) that the participant will receive her/his reimbursement money through her/his sending organization; (2) that the participant will receive reimbursement only if ALL NEEDED TRAVEL DOCUMENTS (tickets, boarding passes, invoices) have been received by the hosting organization. In case not all of the documents are received, we can reimburse your money only partially (for example, if you send us two tickets, we can reimburse only them); (3) the reimbursement cannot exceed 275/360 Euro (depending on your country), as defined by the European Commission; if your travel expenses are higher, you will not receive any reimbursement above the amount of 275/360 Euro (for example, if your tickets cost 300 Euro and you travel from Latvia, you will receive only 275); (4) the transfer of the reimbursement money to the bank account of the sending organization will be realized by the hosting organization within ONE MONTH after the documents have been received. The faster you send us the documents, the sooner you will receive your money :) (5) All tickets paid in other currencies than Euro will be calculated (converted) in Euro, and you will receive your reimbursement money accordingly.

4. Agrees she/he will respect

the other participants, the trainers and experts, and the hosting organization, as well as the hotel staff. Everyone can share their opinion freely without using bad words :) This also includes respect for other cultures :)

5. Agrees she/he will behave responsibly regarding the properties of the hotel (and will required to pay for any damage, e.g. breaking a window).

6. Agrees to be instructed in detail about the safety regulations during the project and to observe these regulations.
